The channel is owned by Grupo Mix de Comunicação, which also owns the Mix FM radio station. MIXTV has established 20 retransmitting stations across the country covering 38 million inhabitants; the station operates three channels, MIX, RBI and SKY, which programming is mainly divided into themed blocks dedicated to both musical and telesales content.
